Charlottetown Tigers Minor Basketball Association Code of Conduct

The Charlottetown Tigers Minor Basketball Association believes that every child registered in our program deserves the right to learn basketball skills in a safe environment where all children can learn and participate.

If a child's behavior does not allow this to happen, the child will be addressed by their coach. If the behavior continues, parents will be asked to speak to the child and possibly intervene. If the child's behavior continues to be disruptive, they may be suspended from the program for a number of sessions, or told they can not continue to participate this year.

This protocol will be followed when it is believed that a child or children are not allowing a coach to coach or are not allowing other children to learn skills to the best of their ability. The final decision on a child participating in the Charlottetown Tigers Minor Basketball Program rests with the executive of the association.
